Agenda for the day (all times approx.)

- 09.15 Meet at the Nurettin Ersin Pasa Mosque in Girne
- 09.30 Depart for Nicosia
- 10.30 Arrive at starting point close to the Green Line and walk along the frontier
- 11.30 Visit to Lapidary Museum
- 12.00 Visit to Eaved house
- 13.00 Lunch in the Buyuk Han where we will enjoy a mixed Cypriot plate at the Great Inn
- 14.00 On leaving the restaurant we will walk to Lokmaci Gate and follow the Green Line to Yigitler Bastion where we will meet the coach for our return trip
- 16.00 Arrive Girne

The walk before lunch will be for about 1 hour and after lunch about 40mins and we will be accompanied by an official experienced guide

The cost includes your return coach fare, lunch, entrance fees and your professional English speaking guide for the day. Not included are any drinks.

PLEASE NOTE: As an association we don't ask for prepayment for our activities, but unfortunately, we are going to have to start doing so if people who have made reservations don't attend the activity for whatever reason. Likewise, the association may consider not taking reservations from those members who perpetual cancels their reservation to attend an activity or perpetually no-show at an activity.

ALL attendees must be double vaccinated and present their valid ADA Pass to gain entry both to the Coach Company and the Venue.

Known locally as the 'Green Line', the Buffer Zone within Lefkoşa's medieval city walls. Unlike many medieval fortified cities, this capital city isn't defined by its surrounding walls, venetian bastions still enclose the old part of the city, but a much newer barrier holds sway. The so-called Green Line – a demilitarised buffer zone patrolled by United Nations peacekeepers – scythes through the middle of this city, slicing it in two. This is Europe's last divided capital, but its entwined history straddles both sides of the green line.



This guided walk will explore the old town's atmospheric tangle of alleyways, trace the line along its geometrically perfect route past snowflake-shaped ramparts, which at times can turn into one major problem: narrow lanes end abruptly at cement bunkers and oil-barrel barricades, with a no man's land of abandoned buildings standing beyond the barbed wire fencing. Our guide will take you to many fascinating buildings and artefacts found along the 'green line' explaining about each as we

progress along the walk, you will visit places you thought you knew only to discover on this walk that you didn't plus places you never knew existed.

Included with this walk will be lunch eaten in one of Lefkoşa's most famous buildings, and return coach travel between Girne and Lefkoşa.

During the walk you will visit the Lapidary Museum, Eaved House, Büyük Han, Lokmacı Gate and Yiğitler Bastion to name but a few places.

If you only go on one ATA event -- make sure it's this event, this event will provide you with a unique experience which will live in your mind for ever!
