### Guided walk around the walled city of Famagusta + Lunch & Return Coach – 17/05/2022

# ITINERARY

The coach will leave Karsiyaka Square at 8am and make pickups along the main road in Lapta, Alsancak, Girne, Ozankoy and Catalkoy before travelling over the mountain to Famagusta ( pickup points to be decided )

On arrival in Famagusta we will have a Coffee / Refreshment break at Garga Inn

After coffee we will begin our Walking Tour of the medieval city with Gulter our very experienced guide

Lunch will be around 1pm and will be taken within the walled city

The lunch will be Mezzes followed by Mixed Kebap (Vegetarian or Gluten Free options are available on request)

After lunch we will continue with our walking tour and then meet the coach for our trip back

Some of the sights we will see are the St Peter and St Paul Church, Othello Tower, Sea Gate, St Nicolas Cathedral and many more

The cost of this day trip is approximately **475 / 525 TL per person** and will depend on the number of people going on the event

The price includes the return coach fare, lunch, guide, entrance fee and tips

Throughout the centuries the walled city of Famagusta has been an important part of the history of Cyprus. Enclosed within the fortified walls of this city is some of the most superb medieval architecture in the Middle East, and no less a figure than Leonardo de Vinci is thought to have been involved in the design of its colossal Venetian fortifications. Within these walls there is an intriguing range of monuments, buildings ranging from Churches to Cathedrals and much more besides, including a certain location made famous by the bard William Shakespeare.

Our guide will take you to many fascinating buildings and artefacts often overlooked by the casual stroller explaining about each as we progress along the walk, you may well have visited Famagusta in the past and thought there is nothing there apart from a bustling port, but this gentle stroll will make you change your perception of this fascinating city.

Included with this walk will be lunch eaten in one of Famagusta's traditional Turkish Cypriot restaurants and return coach travel between Girne and Famagusta.



During the walk you will visit St Peter & St Paul Church, Nestorian Church, Twin Churches, Venetian House, St George of the Latins Church, Othello Tower, Sea Gate, St Nicolas Cathedral, St George of the Greeks, St Nicolas Church, Aya Zoni Church, to name but a few places.

If you only go on one ATA event – and want it to be a gentle stroll through history, then this event is the one for you and will also provide you with a unique experience that will live in your mind for ever!
